



Idaho Produce Prescription Collaborative (IdPPC)

Membership requirements:

Membership requires attendance at 3 of 4 meetings per year. IdPPC membership shall be for a term of two (2) years. Members are eligible for reappointment for a total of 3 consecutive years. Meetings occur every quarter.

Participation

- Provide 3 to 5 hours monthly.
- Participate in presentations when requested.
- Review articles sent and give feedback.
- Promote the produce prescription program.
- Discuss solutions to barriers and issues within the program (funding, transportation, language).

Outreach

- Choose two organizations to share the RxFFV program.
- Share factsheets.
- Provide feedback and next steps.
- Focus on eliminating food insecurity in Idaho.
- Engage RxFFV work in your day-to-day activities.
- Explain how you have promoted the IdPPC in your workplace (Quarterly).



Funding

- Help organize and advocate for sustainable funding (government and private sector).
- Engage with other members of the collaborative on funding initiatives and grants.

Student Membership Activities:

Student membership requires attendance at 2 of 4 meetings per year for a 2-year term. Meetings occur every quarter.

- Review 1 to 2 PRx articles a month.
- Write an informative review of PRx articles.
- Provide article informatics.
- Write blogs to inform concerning the RxFFV program and research.

*If organization staff changes occur, then the organization's IdPPC representative will provide an appropriate replacement within 30-45 days of the position being vacated.
